Lawrence Sager, the Alice Jane Drysdale Sheffield Regents Chair at Texas Law, will be presenting.

Lawrence Sager is one of the nation's preeminent constitutional theorists and scholars. Professor Sager came to Texas from New York University School of Law, where he was the Robert B. McKay Professor and Co-Founder of the Program in Law, Philosophy & Social Theory. He has also taught at Harvard, Princeton, Boston University, UCLA, and the University of Michigan. Dean Sager is the author or co-author of dozens of articles, many now classics in the canon of legal scholarship. Sager is the author of two books: *Justice in Plainclothes: a Theory of American Constitutional Practice* (Yale Univ. Press), and *Religious Freedom and the Constitution* (co-authored with Christopher Eisgruber) (Harvard Univ. Press).
