The Puerto Rican Debt Crisis: Looking Ahead

On August 31, 2016, President Obama appointed a seven-member oversight board for Puerto Rico, as authorized by legislation enacted two months earlier. The oversight board, which includes Penn Law Prof. David Skeel and other members with Penn connections, will hold a forum for the Penn community on February 16 at 5:30 pm in Silverman 245A. Penn Law Dean Ted Ruger will welcome the group, after which Chair Jose Carrion and other board members will offer remarks. A question-and-answer session will allow for discourse on the board's work with Puerto Rico Governor Ricardo Rossello on a ten-year fiscal plan, the restructuring of Puerto Rico's debt, and the future of Puerto Rico.
