PI WEEK TPIC EVENT: Litigating to Preserve Public Protections in Deregulatory Times

Time: 4:30pm - 6:00pm

Come listen to Allison Zieve, Director of the [Public Citizen](#) Litigation Group.

In this seminar, one of the nation's foremost public interest regulatory advocates, Allison Zieve of Public Citizen, will use examples of recent lawsuits challenging regulatory delays and rollbacks to show the public interests at stake in federal regulation. She will explain how advocates can use the Administrative Procedure Act to challenge the actions (or inactions) of federal agencies—but will also highlight the difficulties faced when consumer or public-interest groups (as opposed to industry plaintiffs) seek judicial intervention over regulatory policy. Focusing on recent successes in the courts—whether on issues related to fair housing, teen pregnancy prevention programs, student loans, and more—she will explain how public interest advocates can overcome the difficulties they face and still preserve meaningful protections for the public in deregulatory times.
