The Paul G. Haaga, Jr. Lecture in Law, Government, and Public Policy "Russian New Generation Warfare and the Threat to the Free World"

The 2018 Haaga Lecture will be delivered by Lieutenant General H. R. McMaster, United States Army, Ret.; former National Security Advisor; and Perry World House Distinguished Visiting Fellow

General McMaster's lecture will focus on the changing nature of modern conflict between nation states as well as non-state actors. His address will highlight diverse tactics Russia uses to interfere with the sovereignty of other nations including the attacks on the 2016 United States presidential election.

The talk will be moderated by Professor Claire Finkelstein, the founder and faculty director of the Penn Law's Center for Ethics and the Rule of Law (CERL).

The Haaga Lecture focuses on leadership and its impact on government. Haaga lecturers provide insight and share their experiences with Penn Law students in an effort to prepare students for leadership roles in their careers. Past Haaga lecturers include former CIA and NSA Director Gen. Michael Hayden; New York Times best-selling author and Presidential Historian for NBC News, Michael Beschloss; and former Secretary of Homeland Security, Michael Chertoff.
