Tara Ramchandani is a Parter at Relman, Dane & Colfax, a civil rights law firm based in D.C., where she maintains a varied civil rights litigation practice, representing individuals and organizations in housing, lending, and public accommodations discrimination cases. She is a fellow with the Student Borrower Protection Center and teaches as an adjunct professor at the University of Michigan Law School. Tara also regularly presents on civil rights issues across the country.
