Join BLSA on **November 11 at 7:30 pm** in a conversation with Dr. Wendy Greene about the instrumental CROWN Act. The CROWN Act, which stands for “Creating a Respectful and Open World for Natural Hair,” is a law that prohibits race-based hair discrimination in



hairstyles. Dr. Greene served as the legal expert for the California CROWN Act, the first of its kind nationwide, and advocates for similar anti-discrimination laws in other states. Dr. Greene comes to Penn Law to discuss the prevalence of race-based hair discrimination and strategies for navigating professional spaces for people with textured hair.
