TROVER AND CONVERSION.

Where the plaintiff's sheep, having broken out of his lot, mingled with those of the defendant, which were being driven along the highway, and were driven by the defendant, with his own, to his yard, and there separated and turned into the highway, and driven towards the place where they had joined the defendant's flock. *Held*, that this did not amount either to an unlawful taking, or to a conversion: *Van Valkenburgh v. Thayer*, 57 Barb.

*Damages to Riparian Owner*.—Log-owners are liable to the riparian proprietor for the actual damages caused by travelling upon the banks of a floatable stream for the purpose of propelling their logs: *Hooper v. Hobson*, 57 Me.
