

NOTE.

In April of this year the management of the *American Law Register* became involved in financial difficulties and were obliged to stop the publication and make an assignment for the benefit of their creditors. The copyright, subscription list, etc., has passed into the possession of the University of Pennsylvania Press, who have undertaken to furnish the subscribers with the remaining unpublished numbers of the magazine for 1891. This involves the publishing of nine numbers of the magazine, from April to December, inclusive. The late management had on hand at the time of their assignment a considerable amount of matter, which the University of Pennsylvania Press have published in this and the April numbers. All of the nine numbers for 1891 are to be sent to the subscribers before the 15th of January, 1892, thereby making good, as far as in them lies, the promise of the D. B. Canfield Company, Limited. And it will be the endeavor of the present management to supply to the subscribers for the remainder of the year a periodical which shall be in size and in general characteristics similar to that which they have been accustomed to find in the previous numbers of the *American Law Register*. It is expected that they will be able to send to the subscribers copies of the June, July, August and September numbers within ten days.

With the commencement of the new year the Editorial Management, mentioned in the first page of the April number and of this number, will take entire charge of the Magazine.
