

pose of the authors inevitably lessens somewhat the attractiveness of the work to an American reader, who will prefer to read the cases rather than second-hand summaries and will scarcely find that suggestions are made in the monograph which have not previously been made in the wide native literature on the subject. It may, however, suggest to him the desirability of somewhat similar studies in comparative law, which will treat of the more significant developments in the modern civil law with which American scholars deserve to be more generally acquainted.
