Salvatore Riccobono, LL. D., University of Palermo. Professor Riccobono has filled the chair of Professor of Roman Law at the University of Palermo since 1897. In 1924 he was made Doctor of Civil Law, "*Honoris Causa*," by the University of Oxford, and this year he was elected an honorary member of the Society of Public Teachers of Law.

Professor Riccobono delivered a course of lectures at the University of London in 1924 and he has also lectured at Oxford. He is the author of many well-known works both on Roman Law of the classic period and its modern development.
